DECISION ON THE REMUNERATION OF THE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS AND THE ALTERNATES OF THE BOARD OF APPEAL

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN CHEMICALS AGENCY

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/67/EEC, 93/105/EC and 2000/21/EC, and in particular Article 78(3) and second subparagraph of Article 89(3) thereof,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1 *Remuneration*

1. The remuneration of the additional members and their alternates and of the alternates of the permanent members of the Board of Appeal who work on a part-time basis shall vary according to the role in which the member has participated in the treatment of the case and shall be as follows:

	Remuneration per actual day of work (€)	Maximum remuneration per one appeal (€)
Chairperson	500	5000
Rapporteur	400	4000
Other members	300	3000

2. However, in case of several comparable appeals the level of maximum remuneration mentioned above applies only to the treatment of the first case. The maximum remuneration for the following appeals will be half of the maxima mentioned in the above table.

3. Remuneration will be made upon production of a signed detailed specification of actual days of work spent. One day of work amounts to 7,5 hours of work.

4. The Executive Director shall put in place, if needed, more detailed internal rules, in conformity with the financial rules applicable to the Agency.

Article 2
Reimbursement of costs

The guide for the reimbursement of travel, hotel and subsistence expenses for Board members, Committee members and any other experts attending meetings of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), adopted by the Management Board on 18 July 2007 (MB/5/2005/final), shall apply for the reimbursement of costs.

Article 3
Entry into force

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
