# Main Tasks of FORUM art. 77(4) of REACH



- To spread good practise and highlight problems at Community level
- To propose, coordinate and evaluate harmonised enforcement projects and joint inspections
- To identify enforcement strategies, as well as best practise in enforcement
- To develop working methods and tools of use to local inspectors

### Strategies for the Enforcement of REACH and CLP Regulations



Working group B1 was established at the 2nd Forum meeting (May 2008)

Mandate of the Working Group

To prepare and present for adoption by the Forum draft documents on strategy(ies) for enforcement of REACH and on minimum criteria for REACH enforcement

Main objectives:

To identify and present:

- Enforcement strategies for REACH
- Best practice in enforcement
- > Minimum criteria for REACH enforcement

### Strategies for the Enforcement of REACH and CLP Regulations (cont.)



- WG was established at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Forum meeting (May 2008) to examine Strategies for the enforcement of REACH
- Paper on REACH Enforcement Strategies agreed upon by FORUM3 (December 2008)
- Text revised to include CLP reference as part of the activities of the WG for the FORUM Work Program 2012-14
- Final document adopted at FORUM9 covering the strategies for the enforcement of REACH and CLP



### Minimum Criteria for REACH and CLP Inspections

- A WG was established at FORUM3
- Work on REACH minimum criteria for inspections was finalised at FORUM6 (December 2008)
- Text revised to include CLP reference as part of the activities of the WG for the FORUM Work Program 2012-14
- Final document adopted at FORUM9 covering the minimum criteria for REACH and CLP inspections

## **Initial objectives and mandate**



### **Objective:**

Develop minimum criteria for REACH inspections for ensuring the level playing field within the internal market and better coordination of REACH enforcement within EU and EEA – EFTA states

#### Mandate:

- Draft minimum criteria for REACH inspections, taking into account the thought starter paper prepared by the Forum WG "Strategies for REACH enforcement"
- Consider the provisions of the Market Surveillance Regulation ('AMS Regulation')



### Minimum Criteria for REACH and CLP Inspections – key elements

- Organisation and planning
- Carrying out REACH and/or CLP inspection
- Action following REACH and/or CLP inspection
- Checking and review of arrangement for REACH and CLP
- Reporting
