How to make a plan for exposure scenario development in a SIEF/Consortium/SLT.

- Take the ES from as much as possible from publicly available data, e.g. from a sector group
- Tier1 Exposure assessment should be drafted by scientists, TIER2, if needed, via exposure data
- Use Descriptors were helpful in developing ES



How to ensure CBI while generating useful data for environmental assessment @ the same time.

• CBI info can be circumvented by using public available info

Use a trustee

 In Envi Risk Assessment CBI is crucial: tonnage level and number of sites. Can be solved by worst case approach
