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

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3000 applications processed since 1 September 2013 (1500 in 2013)

- Large majority for national authorisations and mutual recognitions
- Active substances:

New active substances: 8


Annex I inclusion: 1

Applications: forecast vs reality






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Register for Biocidal Products (R4BP 3.1)






IT tools

- R4BP 3 (submission): 2 releases
 3rd release in December 2014 major improvements
- IUCLID (scientific data): specific tools since v 5.5
- SPC editor: foreseen in October 2014
- Migration R4BP2 R4BP 3
- Submission manuals + Manual for competent authorities
- Involvement of stakeholders
- Specific Helpdesk support

Biocidal Products Committee and its Working Groups

- Biocidal Products Committee (BPC):
 - 3 preparatory meetings (2013)
 - 5 meetings in 2014
 - · 18 opinions already adopted
- BPC Working groups:
 - >20 meetings in 2014



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Coordination Group

- Settlement of mutual recognition disputes
 - 3 formal disagreements (2 solved)
 - informal discussions
 - 2 meetings in 2013
 - 6 meetings in 2014
- Forum for discussions on product authorisations:
 - Requirement for renewal applications
 - Format of Summary of Product Characteristics (SPC)
 - Feedback on IT tools
