#### **Active substances**

- Review programme
  - 50 opinions per year
  - CLH process
  - Completion by 2024
- New Review Programme Regulation
- In situ generated active substances



# **Biocidal Products**

- Union authorisation
- Mutual recognition
- Rodenticides
  - Report on RMMs
  - Approvals and authorisations renewals
  - EU comparative assessment
- R4BP



#### **Treated Articles**

- Restrictions when major concern identified
  - Exclusion criteria are met and derogation granted
  - Nature of critical effects and pattern of use
- Specific labelling required in certain cases only
  - A use is not approved
  - Serious concern (e.g. skin sensitizers cat. 1A/1
- Complex Articles



## Sustainable Use

- Report by July 2015
- Key considerations
  - How to promote products with a better profile for the environment or public health?
  - How to monitor use?
  - How to promote best practices to inform endusers on risks and RMMs
- Possible legislative proposal
