## Cancellation of national authorisation on request – Brodifacoum Pasta Bait and Brodifacoum Bait Blocks – NO-2019-0180

We refer to your national authorisation cancellation on request for the two biocidal products Brodifacoum Pasta Bait and Brodifacoum Bait Blocks in the biocidal product family Brodifacoum Family - PT14 – NO-2019-0180. The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby cancels the authorisation.

### Background

Regulation (EU) No. 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation, BPR), is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No. 480. According to Article 49 of the BPR, the Competent Authority that granted the national authorisation of a biocidal product, shall cancel the authorisation at the request of the authorisation holder.

### Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency confirms with this letter that the national authorisation for Brodifacoum Pasta Bait and Brodifacoum Bait Blocks in the biocidal product family Brodifacoum Family - PT14 – NO-2019-0180, is cancelled by your request, subject to Article 49 in BPR, cf. § 1 of the Norwegian Biocide Regulation.

### Phase-out period of existing stocks, when relevant

According to Article 52 of the BPR, when an authorisation is cancelled, a period of grace for the making available on the market and use of existing stocks should be granted. The products can be made available on the market for up to 180 days from the date of this letter, and the use of existing stocks is given an additional 180 days.
