Extension of the expiry date for the national authorisation of Creosote BPF Koppers - NO-2017-0128

We refer to your communication of 20 November 2020 concerning the expiry date of the authorisation of the biocidal product Creosote BPF Koppers containing the active substance creosote. The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby extend the expiry date until 31 October 2021.

Background

The Commission has adopted by means of an implementing act, a commission implementing decision on the terms and conditions of the authorisation of the biocidal product in accordance with Article 15 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products. Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No. 480. The decision (COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION (EU) 2020/1038 of 15 July 2020) postpones the expiry date of approval of creosote for use in biocidal products of product-type 8 until 31 October 2021.

Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby confirms that the expiry date of the authorisation granted for the biocidal product Creosote BPF Koppers - NO-2017-0128 containing creosote has been extended until 31 October 2021 according to Article 50 of Regulation (EU) NO 528/2012 concerning amendment of an authorisation at the request of the authorisation holder.

Apart from the extension of the expiry date outlined above, the authorisation conditions as state in the authorisation letter dated 30 March 2017 are valid.

No fee will be charged regarding the change of the expiry date.

Appeal

The decision can be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment, in accordance with Article 28 of the Public Administration Act. The complaint must be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within 3 weeks after receipt of this letter, in accordance with Article 29 of the Public Administration Act.
