**On the amendment of the authorisation of the biocidal product family  
ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN in Latvia**

On 27<sup>th</sup> November 2015 Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) authorised **ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN** family in accordance with Article 33 of *Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products* (Regulation (EU) No 528/2012). The authorisation number **LV/2015/MR/011** is valid until **31<sup>st</sup> December 2023**.

According to the *Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2022/1005 of 23 June 2022 on the unresolved objections regarding the terms and conditions of the authorisation of the biocidal product family Alphachloralose Grain referred by France and Sweden in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council*, the biocidal product family **ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN** does not fully meet the conditions laid down in Article 19(1), point (b)(iii), of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012. The biocidal product family has unacceptable effects on animal health and by analytical tests conducted on the poisoned animals is confirmed, that a significant number of poisoning incidents with alphachloralose involving cats had occurred.

Therefore, in line with Article 19(5) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, the use of the mentioned biocidal product family is subject to appropriate risk mitigation measures to ensure that exposure of humans and the environment to that biocidal product is minimised.

Based on above mentioned, LEGMC authorises **ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN** according to Article 19(5) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 with the following amendments:

1. Removal of the general public as a user category;
2. Addition of the following risk mitigation measures which must be included on the product label:
  - Indicate on the packaging, via well visible pictogram, the risk for humans and non-target organisms (cats);

- Indicate on the packaging in a well visible manner the obligation to use bait box to apply rodenticides.

LEGMC would like to inform that **LODI S.A.S.** is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal product family **ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN** as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask **LODI S.A.S.** to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.

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
