# Extended expiry date for Teknos Norge AS – Teknol Aqua 1410-01– NO-2014-0040

With reference to R4BP3 communication no. NRN-C-1699397-68-00/F dated 8 December 2023, concerning the expiry date for the biocidal product Teknol Aqua 1410-01, NO-2014-0040.

#### Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby grants Teknos Norge AS a postponement of the expiry date for the authorisation for the biocidal product Teknol Aqua 1410-01 on the Norwegian market. The expiry date is postponed from 24 January 2024 to 30 April 2024.

The product is mutual recognised in Norway under the terms and conditions as described in the final Norwegian Summary Product Characteristic (SPC) attached to the R4BP3 asset case no. NO-0004202-0000. The final SPC can also be found on the website of the European Chemicals Agency here: <u>Information on biocides - ECHA (europa.eu).</u>

The grant of extension of expiry date is given in accordance with Article 5 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 (renewal of authorisations of biocidal products).

# Background

Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation, BPR), is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No 480.

For the reference Member State for the renewal of the biocidal product, Denmark, the expiry date of the authorisation for Teknol Aqua 1410-01 is 30 April 2024. For authorisations that are mutual recognised, it is agreed among the Member States that these authorisations shall have the same expiry date as the national authorisation granted by the reference Member State (c.f. CA-Sept14-Doc.5.7 –Final).



The current expiry date for the Norwegian authorisation is 24 January 2024.

## Evaluation by the Norwegian Environment Agency

The decision is based on CA-Sept14-Doc.5.7 –Final which states that that authorisations that are mutual recognised shall have the same expiry date as the reference Member State.

### Right to appeal

This decision may be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment.

An appeal shall be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within three weeks after receipt of this letter.
