

Uta JENSEN-KORTE

Dr. Uta Jensen-Korte is a chemist with more than 30 years of experience in the field of international regulatory chemical issues.

Since September 2016 she is retired from her position as Director General of the European Association of Chemical Distributors (Fecc).

After achieving a Doctorate in Organic Chemistry at the University of Münster (Germany) in 1981, Uta Jensen-Korte stayed at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) as a Post-Graduate fellow.

In 1983, she started her career with Bayer AG (Germany) – first in the research department, later on in the production and finally, in the marketing department.

At the beginning of 1997, she joined the European Chemical Industry Council (Cefic) where she was nominated Director in 2002. During this period she focused on issues related to European and international chemicals management and more specifically on REACH.

Before joining Fecc, she worked six years for the European Commission, Directorate-General Enterprise and Industry, starting in 2004, where her main responsibility was to co-ordinate and to lead the implementation of the CLP Regulation (Classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures) and to contribute to international chemical regulatory policies and programmes.
