Acceptance of administrative change to the authorisation for Kurt Obermeier GmbH – Koralan GL 220 Biocidal Product Family – NO-2021-0218

With reference to the notification dated 14 March 2022 and the notification dated 6 October 2023 for administrative changes to the authorisation of the biocidal product family Koralan GL 220 Biocidal Product Family, R4BP 3 case numbers BC-YM074409-08 and BC-EG089250-50.

The applications are part of grouped submissions with Poland acting as the reference Member State, R4BP3 case numbers BC-PF074395-32 and BC-RL089235-19.

Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby accepts the notified administrative changes to the product authorisation for Koralan GL 220 Biocidal Product Family on the Norwegian market.

Terms and conditions for the change to the authorisation

The revised terms and conditions are described in the final Norwegian Summary Product Characteristic (SPC) attached to the R4BP3 asset no. NO-0027304-0000. The final SPC can also be found on the website of the European Chemicals Agency here: [Information on biocides - ECHA \(europa.eu\)](https://european-chemicals-agency.europa.eu). The terms and conditions as stated in the authorisation letter dated 3 December 2021 also apply.

Where the changes approved in this letter have any consequences to the content on or the design of the product label, an electronic copy of the revised label(s) for the relevant products shall be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency by email (biocides@miljodir.no). The electronic copy of the label(s) must be submitted within three months from the date of this letter. Please mark the email with the authorisation number.

The approval is given in accordance with Article 6(4) of Regulation (EU) No 354/2013, c.f. Article 50 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation, BPR).

Background

Regulation (EU) No. 528/2012 and Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 are implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No 480.

The procedure for applications for administrative notifications to authorisations are set out in Article 6 of Regulation (EU) No 354/2013.

The notification concerns

Kurt Obermeier GmbH has notified administrative changes to the authorisation of Koralan GL 220 Biocidal Product Family on the Norwegian market as part of two group submissions. The notified changes concerns: I) Addition of two manufacturer of the active substance, where the technical equivalence between the substances from the two manufacturers, manufacturing locations and processes has been established by the Agency in accordance with Article 54 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, and the manufacturer or importer is listed in accordance with Article 95(2) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, as referred to in Section 1 of Title 1 to the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 354/2013. II) Change in the name or address of the authorisation holder which remains in the EEA, as referred to in Section 1 of Title 1 of the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 354/2013. The name is changed from Kurt Obermeier GmbH & Co. KG to Kurt Obermeier GmbH. III) Change in the name, the administrative details or the formulating location of the biocidal product formulator, where the biocidal product composition and the formulating process remain unchanged, as referred to in Section 2 of Title 1 of the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 354/2013. The name is changed from Kurt Obermeier GmbH & Co. KG to Kurt Obermeier GmbH.

Evaluation by the Norwegian Environment Agency

The Norwegian Environment Agency considers the changes to meet the conditions in Title 1, Section 1 and Section 2 of Annex to Regulation (EU) no 354/2013 and therefore are acceptable.

Right to appeal

This decision may be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment.

An appeal shall be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within three weeks after receipt of this letter.
