Extension of the expiry date for the national authorisation of ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN – NO-2019-0181

We refer to the R4BP3 communication of 18 June 2021, concerning the expiry date of the authorisation of the biocidal product family ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN containing the active substance alphachloralose. The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby extend the expiry date until 31 December 2023.

Background

The Commission has adopted by means of an implementing act, a commission implementing decision on the terms and conditions of the authorisation of the biocidal product in accordance with Article 15 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products. Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No. 480. The decision COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION (EU) 2021/333 of 24 February 2021 postpones the expiry date of approval of alphachloralose for use in biocidal products of product-type 14 until 31 December 2023.

The reference Member State for the re-evaluation, France have already extended the authorisation for the biocidal product family ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN until 31 December 2023.

Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby confirms that the expiry date of the authorisation granted for ALPHACHLORALOSE GRAIN has been extended until 31 December 2023.

Apart from the extension of the expiry date outlined above, the authorisation conditions as state in the authorisation letter dated 18 December 2019 are valid.

No fee will be charged regarding the change of the expiry date.

Appeal

The decision can be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment, in accordance with Article 28 of the Public Administration Act. The complaint must be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within 3 weeks after receipt of this letter, in accordance with Article 29 of the Public Administration Act.
