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On authorisation of the Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family through mutual recognition in Latvia

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) has evaluated an application submitted by Evans Vanodine International on 13th August 2015 concerning an authorisation of Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family through mutual recognition in Latvia.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics developed by the reference Member State – United Kingdom.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 34 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products (regulation 528/2012), LEGMC authorises the Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family.

Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family contains active substance **iodine** (CAS No.7553-56-2, EC No.231-442-4) at the concentration range **1.8-2.84%**.

LEGMC assigns the authorisation number **LV/2019/MR/009** for Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family.

The authorisation number is valid until **6th March 2029**.

The authorisation number shall be indicated on the label of the biocidal products.

The authorisation of the Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family is granted on the following terms:

- Product type: 3 – Veterinary hygiene;
- Target organisms: bacteria, yeasts and viruses;
- Fields of use: to be used on surfaces and equipment in animal housing and transport vehicles;
- Methods: spraying, foaming, dipping and immersion;
- Users: professionals;
- Product description: soluble concentrate;

- Pack sizes and packaging material: according to SPC;
- Product stability: up to 36 months.

The authorisation applies only to the Evans' Iodine-Based Surface Disinfection Biocidal Product Family in the composition, form and packing for which the first authorisation is granted by reference Member State.

The information on the label (and if applicable an enclosed instruction of use) shall be as it is indicated in the first authorisation of above mentioned product family, taking into account also the information which is stated in the Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics issued by reference Member State.

The information on the label shall be in Latvian.

Notwithstanding content of the label specified above, requirements stated in:

- Article 69 Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products;
- Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of the substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006;
- all other relevant legislation shall be applied.

Evans Vanodine International shall inform LEGMC about any changes in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 of 18th April 2013 on changes of biocidal products authorised in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

If the first authorisation issued by reference Member State is amended or revoked, the authorisation may be re-opened for review before 6th March 2029.

Application on renewal of an authorisation shall be submitted according to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 of 7 March 2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for the renewal of authorisations of biocidal products subject to mutual recognition.

Additionally LEGMC would like to inform that Evans Vanodine International is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal products, as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask Evans Vanodine International to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.

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
